NCHS Project Fee Grants

The New York Federal Statistical Research Data Center (NYRDC) offers grant support to help cover fees charged by the National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) for the use of restricted-access NCHS microdata.

Researchers at institutions that are members of the NYRDC Consortium are eligible for these grants. Additionally, researchers must

- have a project that has been approved by NCHS
- attest that they have attempted and been unable to obtain grant or institutional funding to cover the NCHS project fees.

The maximum grant will be \$3,000 per project. Funds are limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. A researcher may only receive an NCHS project fee grant once every two years. Each member institution will be limited to two grants per fiscal year.
